COMPONENTS OF A CURL

Match the term to the description.

Base

determines the amount of movement of the section of hair; the beginning portion of the hair between the scalp and the first turn of the hair

Stem (Arc)

the portion of the hair that creates the curl and determines the size of the curl

Circle

area between straight or curved partings within a shape; the section of hair on which the tool or pincurl is placed
