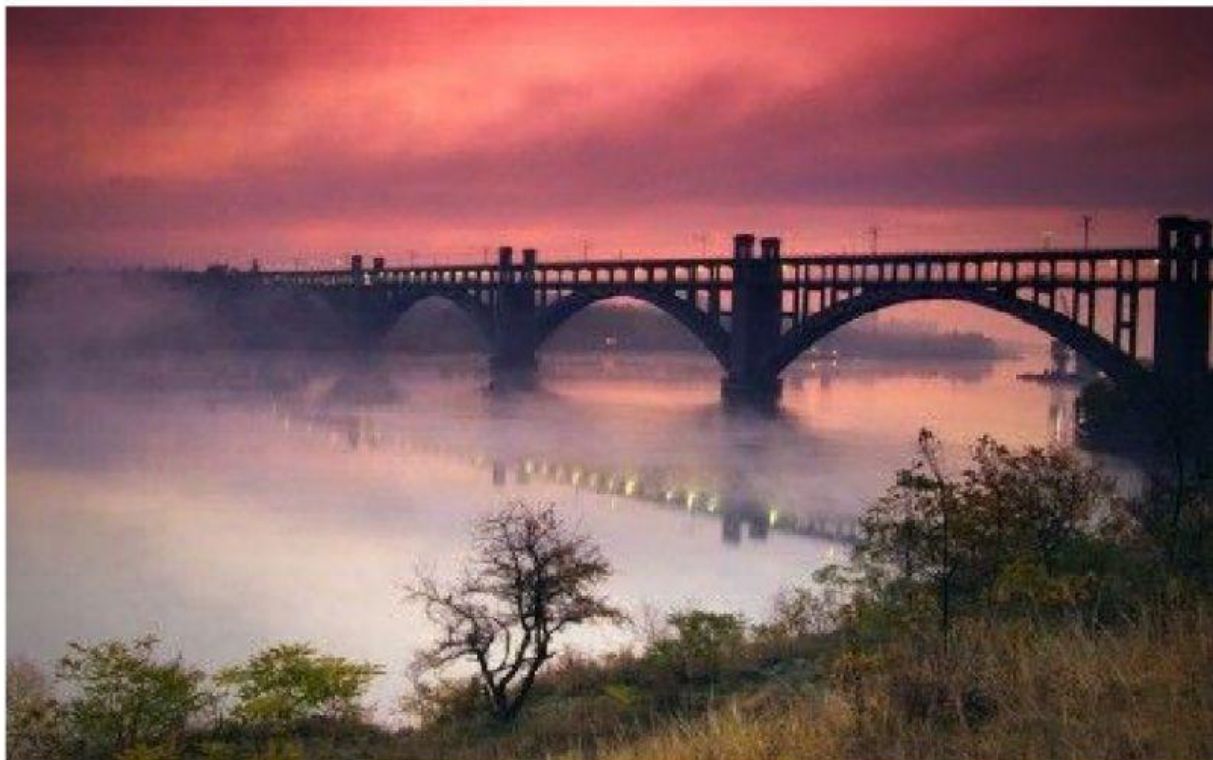

On a bridge in Khortytsia



I think everyone has heard about the place called Khortytsia - the largest island on the Dnieper river, the home of the Cossacks the Zaporizhian Sich.
