

## THE BUTTERFLY LIFE CYCLE

It all starts when a female butterfly (lay) \_\_\_\_\_ her eggs usually on the leaves of plants. A caterpillar (grow) \_\_\_\_\_ inside the egg and when it is ready, it (leave) \_\_\_\_\_ the “egg home” to enter the big outside world! In this stage, the caterpillar (eat) \_\_\_\_\_ a lot and it (become) \_\_\_\_\_ big and strong.
