Who was William Shakespeare?

William Shakespeare is one of the most famous British _____. He wrote many _____ such as Romeo and Juliet and Hamlet.

Despite being so well-known we don't have much information about him; even his name is spelt differently each time it appears, ranging from 'Shak-peare' to 'Shaksper'. People have argued about whether he wrote the plays, although these days he's generally accepted as the author of about thirty-eight plays. He also wrote lots of famous _____.

He has made a successful career in London first as an actor with a group called the Lord Chamberlain's Men and then as a _____. In the UK Shakespeare is taught in schools, although a lot of the plays are actually very funny; some parts are also incredibly rude. Both rich and poor people could enjoy his plays - it was like going to the cinema - and only later on did the theatre become more exclusive.

Some famous quotations from Shakespeare include common phrases such as the 'green-eyed monster' (meaning jealousy) mentioned in Othello and the idea of being 'eaten out of house and home' for someone who has got a greedy guest from Henry IV. The most famous quote is 'To be or not to be' from Hamlet.

Today you can still visit the house where he was born in Stratford-Upon-Avon. In London you can watch plays staged at Shakespeare's Globe, a reconstruction of the _____ he worked for.
