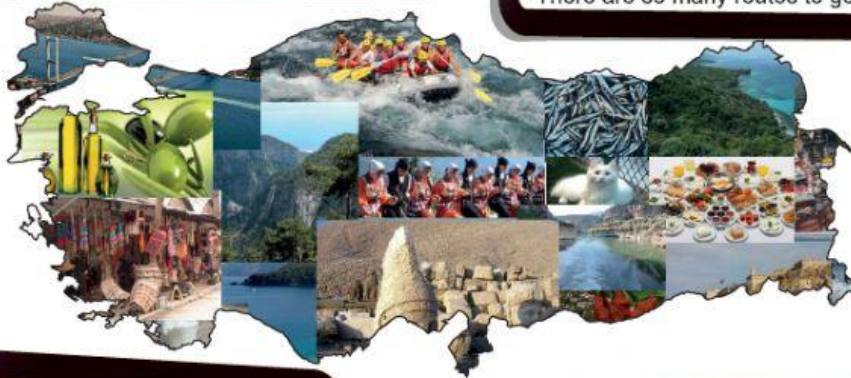
TRAVEL TO TURKEY

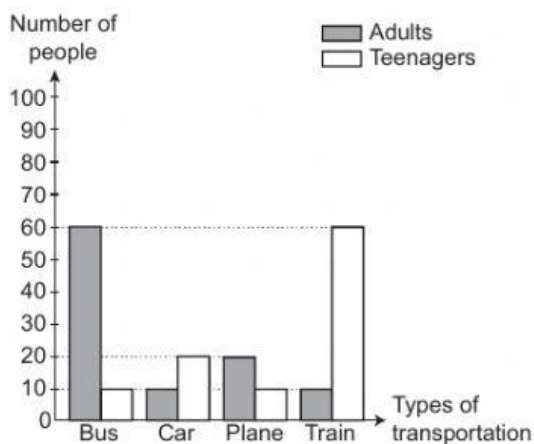
