2. The harpsichord usually had two manuals or keyboards. It could not produce dynamics. The harpsichord was the main instrument employed in the basso continuo. It is one of the most distinctive sounds of the Baroque Era and was the most favored instrument in solo music.

3. The new violin family of instruments slowly replaced the preceding viol family. A typical string quartet was formed by two violins, a viola and a cello. There were string orchestras.
