

Using Measuring Cups

A recipe and questions.

Easy Cake Mix Bars

Ingredients:

One box of yellow cake mix $\frac{1}{3}$ cup of canola oil

One large egg $\frac{1}{3}$ cup of sprinkles

1 cup of white chocolate chips $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of milk

Step 1: Preheat oven to 350°.

Step 2: In a large bowl, combine cake mix, egg, milk and oil
(mixture will be thick).

Step 3: Stir in baking chips and sprinkles.

Step 4: Spread into a greased 15x10x1-in. baking pan.

Step 5: Bake for 18-20 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in
the center comes out clean.

Step 6: Cool completely in pan on a wire rack. Cut into bars.
