1. Reading is generally a passive activity.
2. Generally, we read while sitting or lying down with just our eyes moving across the page sometimes we can engage with a text that way.
3. More often, we need to use more active reading strategies to meet our reading purpose and to stay engaged with a text.
4. Sometimes, we need to change up our reading strategies reading more actively is one way to approach it.
5. You could take notes or annotate while you read.
6. You could take brain breaks or read out loud you could stop and ask yourself questions.
7. Some readers like to stop and summarize what they read summarizing helps them to assess their own understanding as they read.
8. If you can't summarize what you just read, you probably need to choose another reading strategy to try.
9. Strong readers have a toolbox of strategies that they can apply for different reading purposes.
