

FUTURE TENSES REVISION

Match each way of expressing future on the left with the situation(s) of its use on the right.

1. going to	for a definite plan or arrangement for the nearest future (with words like TOMORROW, ON SATURDAY, etc.)
2. Future Simple	for a plan, an intention or a decision
3. Present Continuous	for the speaker's spontaneous reaction at the time of speaking (e.g. offering help) for a prediction for a promise
