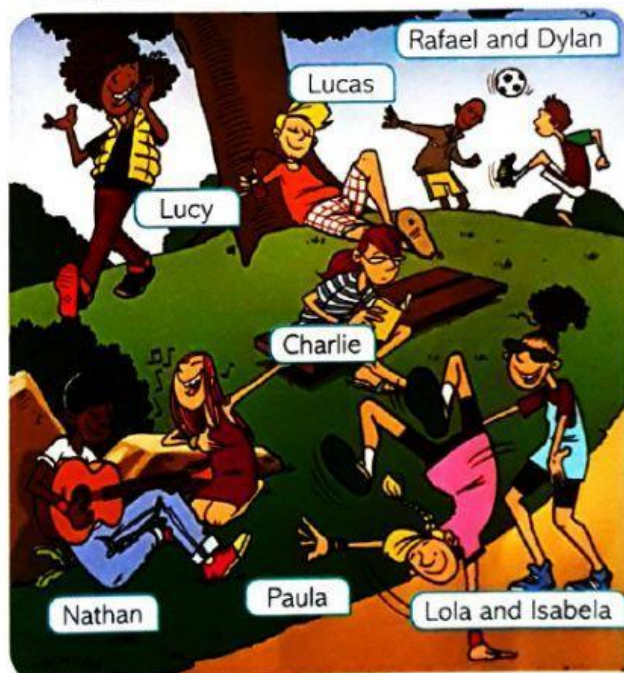

Affirmative	Negative
Yes, I am .	No, I'm not .
Yes, you are .	No, you aren't .
Yes, he / she / it is .	No, he / she / it isn't .
Yes, we / you / they are .	No, we / you / they aren't .
