- 6 = half past
- 7 = twenty five minutes to
- 8 = twenty to
- 9 = quarter to
- 10 = 10 minutes to
- 11 = 5 minutes to
- 12 = o'clock

It's ten past eight.



It's twenty-five past seven.



It's six o'clock.



It's twenty past one.



It's twenty-five to three.



It's a quarter past four.



It's twenty to eleven.
