Anne Frank was a young Jewish German girl who became internationally famous after the publication of her diary but she never enjoyed her fame because the book was published after her death. In the diary she _____ the nightmare reality of eight people crowded in a small place, but also her dreams, hopes and feelings of a young girl. "I still believe, in spite of everything, that people are still truly good at heart..."

Anne Frank _____ in 1929 in Germany. She had a small family: her father - a German officer from World War I, her mother, and a sister called Margot who was three years older than her.

In 1933 her family _____ to the Netherlands to start a new life because they were afraid of Hitler. Anne _____ a very studious and hard working student who had a passion for books. She loved reading and dreamt of being a famous writer. She was also a very energetic and outgoing girl. She _____ many friends in the Netherlands and sent long hours playing with her friends before she was taken as a hostage.

In June 1942, Anne _____ a notebook for her thirteenth birthday. She _____ to use it as a diary and _____ about her dream before she became a writer. In July, she and her family were ordered to go to a work camp so they _____ to hide in the attic of her father's workplace. All the time, they _____ the small space with another family for two years. They survived thanks to some friends who regularly sent them food.

Unfortunately, in August 1944, German security police discovered them and arrested its occupants. Anne was sent to the Auschwitz concentration camp. Anne died of typhus in March 1945. Her diary was found and given to her father. It is one of the most widely read books in the world today.
