Don't use contractions

1. When I \_\_\_\_\_(do) the washing-up, I \_\_\_\_\_(break) a plate.
2. While Tom \_\_\_\_\_ (play) the piano, his mother \_\_\_\_\_ (do) the washing-up.
3. He \_\_\_\_\_ (drink) some juice and then he \_\_\_\_\_(eat) a few chips.
4. I \_\_\_\_\_(have) dinner when I suddenly \_\_\_\_\_ (hear) a loud bang.
5. When my father \_\_\_\_\_(work) in the garden, an old friend \_\_\_\_\_ (pass) by to see him.
