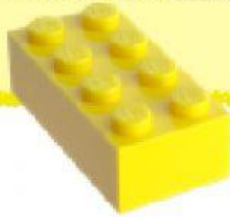

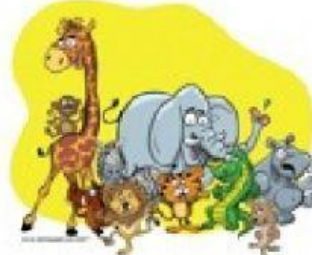


METAPHORS
