



First read these two paragraphs and complete with the words.

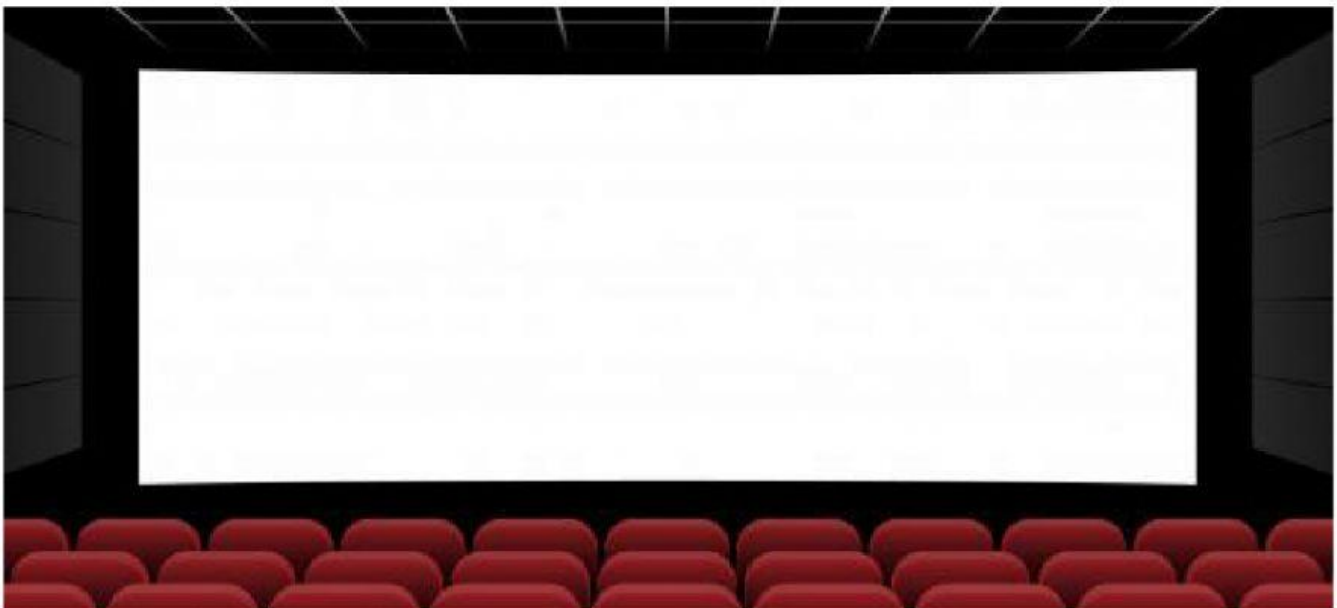
