Franciszek Żwirko was born in 1895 in Święciany near Wilno. He _____ in the Russian Army during the First World War. After the war he _____ to reborn Poland. A few years later, in 1923, Żwirko _____ from an aviation school in Bydgoszcz and a higher pilotage school in Grudziądz. He was a fighter pilot. In 1929 he _____ to work at the University Aeroclub where he _____ friends with Stanisław Wigura.

They _____ together across Europe, won some Polish contests and _____ part in international competitions, where they _____ Poland. In 1932 they _____ the International Tourist Plane Competition Challenge and they _____ national heroes in Poland. On 11 September 1932 Franciszek Żwirko and Stanisław Wigura _____ in a plane crash in the forest in Cierlicko near Cieszyn. They were _____ together at Powązki Cemetery in Warsaw.
