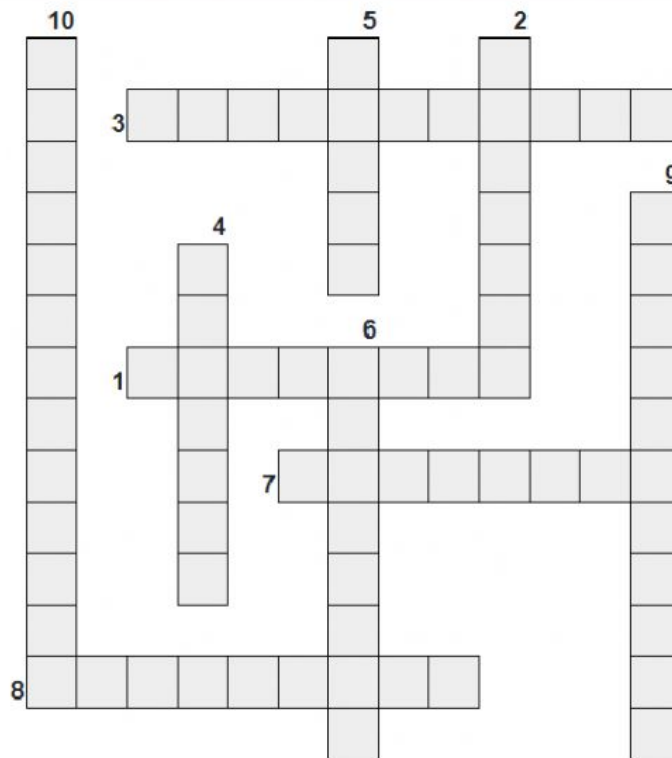


WEATHER AND CLIMATE
