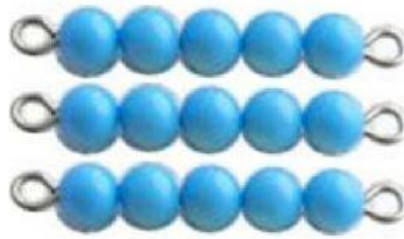


Multiples of a Number

A multiple of a number:

It contains another number an exact multiple of times. It means there is nothing left over.

It is the product of numbers or result of multiplication.



$$5 \times 3 = 15$$

15 is a multiple of 5
because 15 contains 5 exactly 3
times. There is no remainder.
