

Les Couleurs

The spelling of French colours changes depending on the gender (masculin/feminin) and number (singular/ plural) of the object you are describing. The masculine spelling is the original form, the feminin form adds an e, and you add s to either masculine or feminin if there are more than one object (plural forms).

Orange never changes

Blanc becomes blanche in feminin form, Violet becomes violette in feminin form

If it already ends in e, you do not add another e for feminin unless it is é, nor do you add an extra s for plural
