### IRREGULAR VERBS

**S + V (forme spéciale)**

She **went** to London last year.

**S + did not + verb ( infinitif )**

She **didn't** go to Cardiff.

**Did + S + verb ( infinitif )?**

Did she **go** to Trafalgar Square?
