Most of the verbs:

+	<p>Subject + V₂</p> <p>I lived in Vilnius. Mark slept at night.</p>
-	<p>Subject + didn't + V₁</p> <p>I didn't live in Kaunas. Mark didn't sleep at night.</p>
?	<p>Did + subject + V₁?</p> <p>Did you live in Kaunas? Did Mark sleep at night?</p>

Verb BE (was (I, he, she, it), were (you, we, they))

~~Did you be~~ at home?

+ **Subject + V₂**

I was at home.

- **Subject + was not/ were not**

I wasn't at home.

? **Was/were + subject ... ?**

Were you at home?
