BRIEF INTRODUCTION

The **musical ensembles** are the groups of musicians collectively performing their own repertoire. They are the **band**, **rondalla**, **and chorus**.

A. BAND



This consists of marches, overtures (orchestral pieces at the beginning of an opera or play), symphonic poems, concert pieces, and Filipino folk tunes. They often perform during the military and civic parades, as well as musical competitions. Local theatre also has been written for the band.

B. RONDALLA



Rondalla is a group of musicians playing string instruments. This was first introduced by Spain as estudiantina and comparsa. Rondalla has a similar repertoire as the band. It consists of marches and pasodoble pieces (or any song that is fast and brilliant music in two steps). It also includes medleys and arrangements of Filipino folk songs, overtures, concert pieces, and folk-dance accompaniments. Nowadays, the rondalla instruments are also combined with symphonic or orchestral instruments.

C. CHORUS



Chorus, commonly known as choral music or simply choir, is made up of singers in four different voices namely: bass and tenor (for male), alto and soprano (for female). In the Philippines, it has dramatically expanded in the last fifty years, with the rise of the high-quality choral singing and the production of choral groups in different sectors of society such as church, government, business, and culture.
