BRIEF INTRODUCTION

What is a photo essay?



A **Photo Essay** - is a collection of picture or images that are arranged in a specific order to tell the progression of events, emotions, and concepts. It will often show pictures in deep emotional stages and range from purely photographic works to photographs with captions or small comments to full text essays illustrated with photographs.

How to make photo essay?

Steps in making photo essay:

1. Think about a topic or theme, which you would like to do your essay about. Make sure your theme has a point or tells a story.
2. Write down your ideas for photo composition and then choose the best ones.
3. Take photographs based on the topic or theme you planned. Make sure you have a large variety of photos to choose from.
4. Make sure that your photos flow together and are easily connected visually.
5. Finally, add captions explaining your photos and the story they are portraying.
