Podsetnik:

Naučili smo u prošloj lekciji da se komparativi grad od **prideva** sa nastavkom **-ER**, kao u: nice – nicer, small – smaller.

Ukoliko su pridevi kratki i završavaju se na **suglasnik+samoglasnik+suglasnik** (izuzetak je slovo w), onda se **poslednje slovo duplira**: big – bigger

Ukoliko se pridev završava na **-Y**, onda se dešava sledeće: easy – easier

A ukoliko je **pridev dugačak**, tj. ima **dva ili više slogova** gradimo ga sa **MORE+pridev**: beautiful – **more** beautiful.

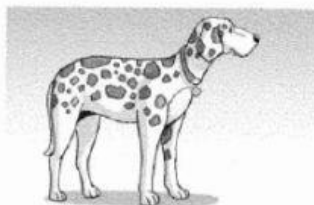

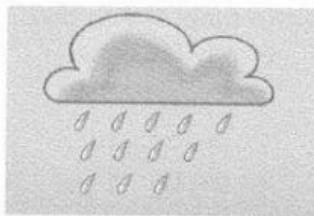
