Director Jake Sigal wants to make the roads safer for bicyclists. He says smarter bikes and accessories could communicate with cars and trucks and help make cycling 0. Task 2

Movie night

0 Maybe you don't want to enjoy your movie alone, maybe you want to call some friends or family members to watch with you. It's your choice. It means that you need to compromise on the type of movie.

1 If you are watching a movie be certain that the content is right for your age group. Different websites can help you determine whether a movie is for your age.

2 It should be a room where you can watch a movie undisturbed for a few hours. Ideally, it should be a relatively quiet room with curtains to block out light. Watching a movie from your bed is a super option.

3 If you want to have an expensive audio set, ask for advice from a professional, who can tell you which would be best for your needs – large speakers or small speakers.

4 While you want the room to be dark so you can see the film clearly, you don't want people falling on the way to the bathroom, so use candles. Also, put a candle on the table with the food, so people can see what they are choosing from.

5 Have lots of blankets and pillows available for a super cozy feel. If you are enjoying your movie with others, ask them to bring extra blankets and pillows.

6 Finger foods are easy to eat while sitting on the couch. Try spicing up regular popcorn. If you're looking for a healthier finger food option, try fresh fruit!

7 If your movie is especially long, having a brief intermission is probably a good idea. Pause the movie at the halfway point so everyone can take a bathroom break and grab extra drinks.

8 It should not be a surprise that people are coming over, because you invited them. Bring in some chairs, mattresses or floor pillows. Cuddles should be a choice – not a necessary result of lack of space.

9 It is good to have various options for thirsty people and people who get sleepy. It is a good idea to use small bottles with straws, and put labels on the bottles so the guests can write their names on their own bottles.

10 The very best part of movie nights (OK, aside from the popcorn), is the discussion after the show. Remember to start your movie early enough that people will have time for a chat when it's over.
