Choose IS or ARE:

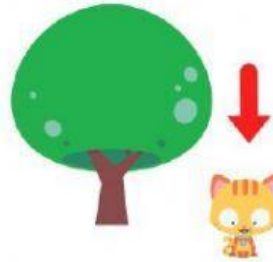
1. There    **IS**      one frog on the log.  
              **ARE**



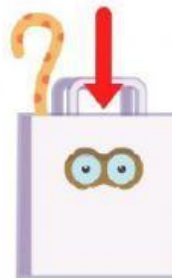
2. There    **IS**      two cats next to the log.
