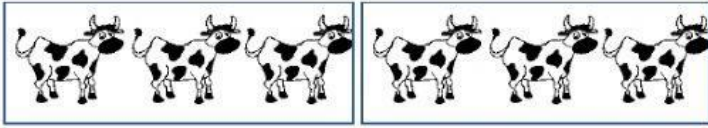


Uncle Hasan has 3 cows and Uncle Umar gives him 3 more cows.



Now, Uncle Hasan has 6 cows.

Since there are **two groups of 3 cows**.
There are **double 3 cows** and it makes **6 cows**.

$$3 + 3 = 6$$

When we add a number to itself, we can also say **DOUBLE**.

Let's learn some doubles. Type the missing numbers.
