Bloody Sunday- sometimes called the Bogside massacre- was an incident on 30 .....1972. In the Bogside area of ....., Northern Ireland, 26 civil-rights.....and bystanders were shot by .....of the British Army. Thirteen males, seven of whom were ....., died immediately or soon after, while the death of another man four-and-a-half-months later was attributed to the injuries he received that day. Two protesters were also injured when they were run down by ..... Five of those wounded were shot in the back. The .....occured during a Northern Civil Rights Association march ; the soldiers involved were .....of the First Battalion of the Parachute Regiment. It is still not known wether the protesters were armed or unarmed, with both sides claiming the enemy fired first.
