Mixed Numbers and Improper Fractions

Convert the improper fractions into mixed number.

$$1) \quad \frac{78}{10} = \quad \text{—} \quad 2) \quad \frac{16}{6} = \quad \text{—} \quad 3) \quad \frac{29}{9} = \quad \text{—}$$

Convert the mixed numbers into improper fractions.
