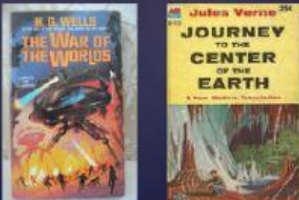

Horror stories about crime and murder



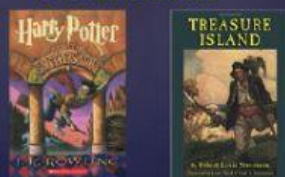
A funny story with a happy ending

are non-human. There is usually a lesson.



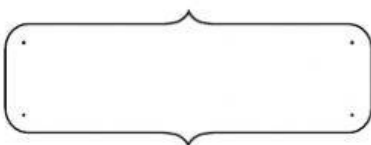
