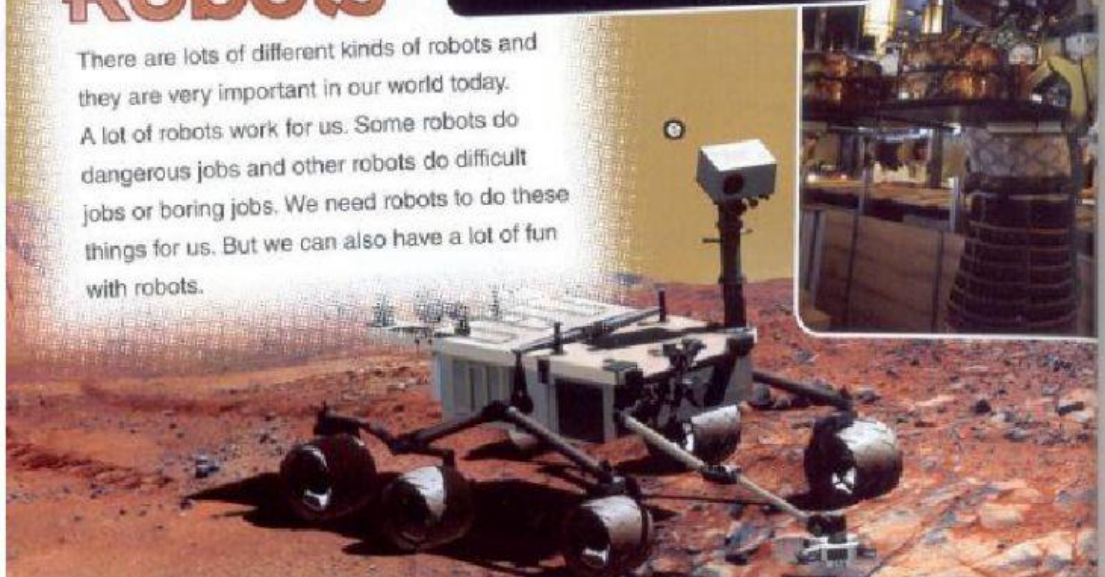


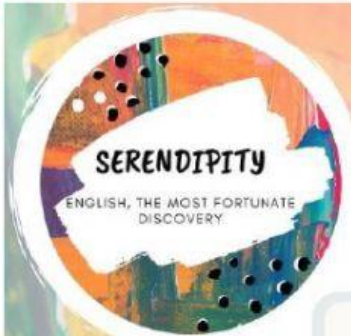
Science Robots

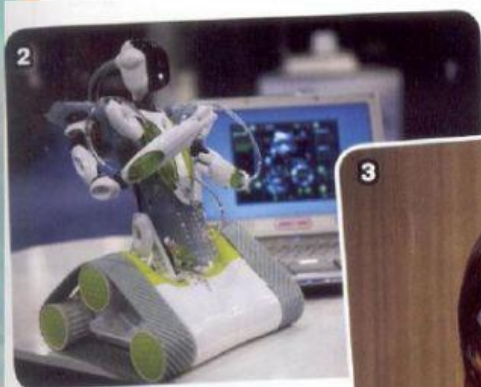

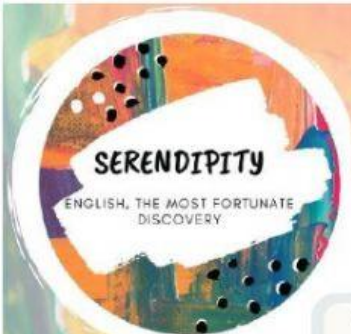
