


1. Match the **characteristics** of plants.

Five empty rectangular boxes for matching the plants to their characteristics.

2. Match **parts of the plants** and their **functions**.



...use sunlight to make food for the plant.

...carry water and minerals to the rest of the plant.

...absorb water and minerals and fix the plant to the ground.

...produce seeds.

3. Read and write **trees, bushes or grasses**.

Trees have a thick hard stem called a trunk. They can be deciduous or evergreen.

Bushes have a thick hard stem with low branches.

Grasses are thin and flexible and usually short.







4. Read and complete this diagram about **photosynthesis**.

Plants make their own food through a process called **photosynthesis**. Plants use **CO₂** (from the air), **sunlight** and **water and minerals** (from the soil) to produce **glucose** (food) and **oxygen**.
