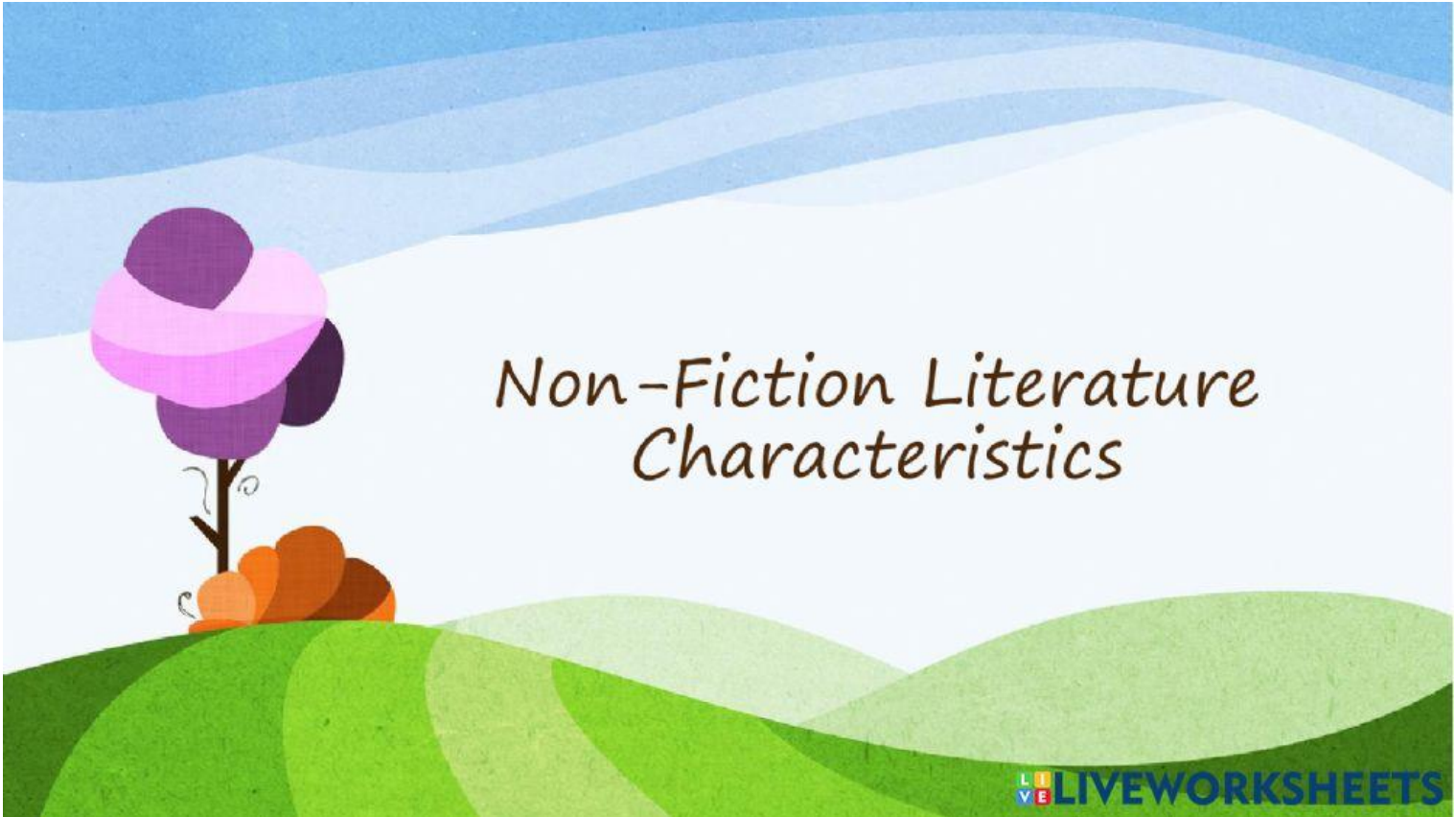

- Table of contents
- Index
- Keywords
- Glossary
- Photographs
- Captions
- Diagrams
- Labels
- Maps, charts and graphs

- Glossary: definitions
- Keywords: to help understand
- Captions: small important details
- Labels: organization
- Photographs: of the actual things written in the piece.
