
Activity 5: Let's read the definitions and complete the sentences:**What are adverbs of frequency?**

Verb	Preposition	Meaning
Log	In/ on	to <u>connect</u> to a computer system by putting in a particular set of letters or numbers: password
Join	In	<u>participate</u> , take part
Turn	On	Power <u>up</u>
	Off	Power <u>off</u>
Sign	up	to <u>join a group</u> or organization
