A: Yes. Life as a famous person can be very stressful.

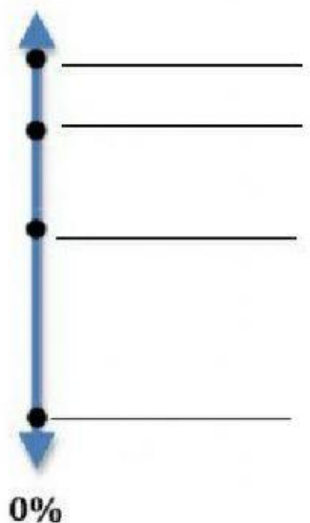
I: Well, thanks again for having us, Ariana.
