<b>Present Simple</b> <b>Positive</b> I go We have You watch They speak  He goes She has It watches speaks <i>every day/usually /always</i>	<b>Present Simple</b> <b>Negative</b> I don't go We don't have You don't watch They don't watch  He doesn't go She doesn't speak It doesn't have  <i>/ on weekend/ sometimes</i>	<b>Present Simple</b> <b>Questions</b> I go? we have ? Do you do karate? they have training?  he go? Does she watch? it have ?  <i>often/in winter/in spring</i>	- Yes, <b>I do.</b> / No, <b>I do not.</b> - Yes, <b>we do.</b> / No, <b>we don't.</b> - Yes, <b>you do.</b> / No, <b>you don't.</b> - Yes, <b>they do.</b> / No, <b>they don't.</b>  - Yes, <b>he does.</b> / No, <b>he doesn't.</b> - Yes, <b>she does.</b> / No, <b>she doesn't.</b> - Yes, <b>it does.</b> / No, <b>it doesn't.</b>
<b>Present Continuous</b> <b>Positive</b> I am going We are having You are doing They are speaking  He is watching She is writing It is reading Look! / Listen! /	<b>Present Continuous</b> <b>Negative</b> I am not running We are not going You are not doing They are not having  He is washing She is not doing It is having  <i>/ at the moment/</i>	<b>Present Continuous</b> <b>Questions</b> Am I going? Are we reading? you doing? they having?  he writing? Is she doing? it having?  <i>now</i>	- Yes, <b>I am.</b> / No, <b>I am not.</b> - Yes, <b>we are.</b> / No, <b>we are not.</b> - Yes, <b>you are.</b> / No, <b>you are not.</b> - Yes, <b>they are.</b> / No, <b>they aren't.</b>  - Yes, <b>he is.</b> / No, <b>he isn't.</b> - Yes, <b>she is.</b> / No, <b>she isn't.</b> - Yes, <b>it is.</b> / No, <b>it isn't.</b>
