Present Simple <u>Positive</u> I go We have You watch They speak He goes She has It watches speaks every day/usually/always	Present Simple <u>Negative</u> I don't go We don't have You don't watch They don't speak He doesn't go She doesn't speak It doesn't have / on weekend/ sometimes	Present Simple <u>Questions</u> Do I go? Do we have? Do you do karate? Do they have training? Does he go? Does she watch? Does it have? often/in winter/in spring	- Yes, I do. / No, I do not. - Yes, we do. / No, we don't. - Yes, you do. / No, you don't. - Yes, they do. / No, they don't. - Yes, he does. / No, he doesn't. - Yes, she does. / No, she doesn't. - Yes, it does. / No, it doesn't.
Present Continuous <u>Positive</u> I am going We are having You are doing They are speaking He is watching She is writing It is reading Look! / Listen! /	Present Continuous <u>Negative</u> I am not running We are not going You are not doing They are not having He is not washing She is not doing It is not having / at the moment/	Present Continuous <u>Questions</u> Am I going?
