The California Gold Rush

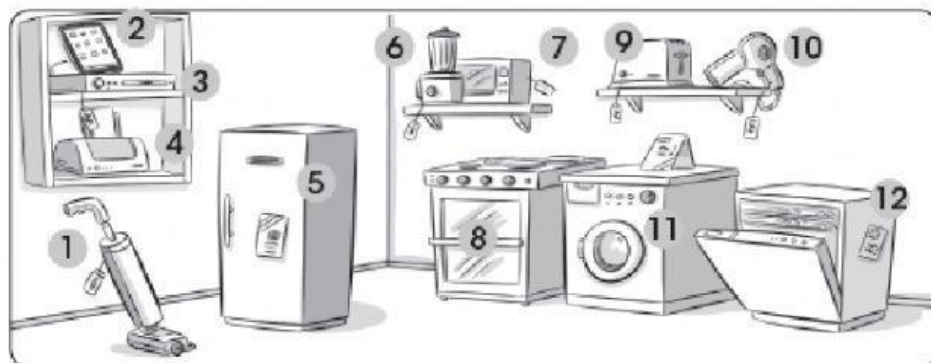
