A 'gap year' is a period of time, usually an academic year, when a student takes a break from formal education. It is often spent travelling or working.

What to do during the gap year:

- Many gap year students choose to do voluntary work. There are plenty of gap year volunteer work options to choose from.
- Lots of gap year students just want to see more of the world. BUT... Most students who are planning a gap year take on a part-time job to save up for the trip.

A gap year doesn't have to be a full year travelling or having adventures: some students travel for three or six months then work for the rest of the year.

Of course there are some advantages and disadvantages of spending a year like this and it can be either beneficial or detrimental.
