

Syllables - Counting

Words are made up of parts called **syllables**.
Each syllable has a vowel sound. A fun way to
 count syllables is to clap as you read each word.

Examples: bat 1 clap 1 syllable
 baby 2 claps 2 syllables
 algebra 3 claps 3 syllables
