IN

- months of the year: in January
- seasons: in summer
- years: in 2020
- decades: in the 90's
- centuries: in the 21st century
- in the morning, in the afternoon, in the evening.

ON

- days of the week: on Monday
- days of the month: on the 26th
- specific dates: on April 1st
- Holidays with the word day: on Christmas day

AT

- time: at 11:30 a.m.
- Holidays WITHOUT the word day: at Christmas
- at night, at midday, at noon, at the weekend.
