MILLAU VIADUCT: THE TALLEST BRIDGE IN THE WORLD!

The Millau Viaduct is a road bridge that crosses the valley of the River Tarn in Southern France. At its tallest point it is 1,125ft. tall, which makes it 62ft. taller than the Eiffel Tower and 121ft. shorter than the Empire State Building. Interestingly, the Millau Viaduct was built more than one hundred years later than the Eiffel Tower, however they were both built by the same company, the Eiffage Group.

Work began in October 2001 and the bridge was officially opened by the French President, Jacques Chirac, on December 14th 2004. Two days later, it was opened for traffic. The bridge is just over one and a half miles long and every day between 10,000 and 25,000 cars cross the bridge.

The architects who were working on the bridge didn't want drivers to feel scared at such a height. So, they designed the bridge in such a way that when driving, it's difficult to look down.
