Add **s** after the verb for **He She It**
No **s** after the verb for **I You We They**



We **play** at the park every Sunday.



She **drinks** milk in the morning.

- My brother / Mark / the policeman... = **HE**
- The rabbit / the pencil / the flower... = **IT**
