

BALLOT	Ideas or information that a group of people deliberately spread to try to influence the thinking of other people
CAUCUS	The right to vote
PARTY	Government that is run by the people who live under it
PROPAGANDA	Closed meeting of party members to determine nominations
SUFFRAGE	The constitutional right to vote
INCUMBENT	The person that a political party names, or nominates, to represent it in a general election
FRANCHISE	Printed form or other item used in voting
DEMOCRACY	A group of people who join together because they share many ideas about what government should do
CONGRESS	An organization working to gain political power or control
GOVERNMENT	A person currently holding office
NOMINEE	The group of people in charge of ruling or managing a country, state, city or other place
POLITICAL PARTY	Legislative group consisting of the House of Representatives and the Senate
