

## ORDER THE JOURNEY OF BLOOD AROUND THE BODY

The heart pumps, and the **blood without (sin) oxygen** goes to the **lungs**.

The **blood without oxygen** goes back to the **heart** through cava vein.

The heart pumps again and the **blood with oxygen and nutrients** goes out through aorta artery to all **the organs** in our body.

In the **lungs**, the blood **takes the oxygen** and goes back (Vuelve) to the **heart** through a vein.

Inside the **organs**, we have capillaries. Through these **capillaries**, the blood drops off (suelta) the nutrients and the oxygen in the organs.
