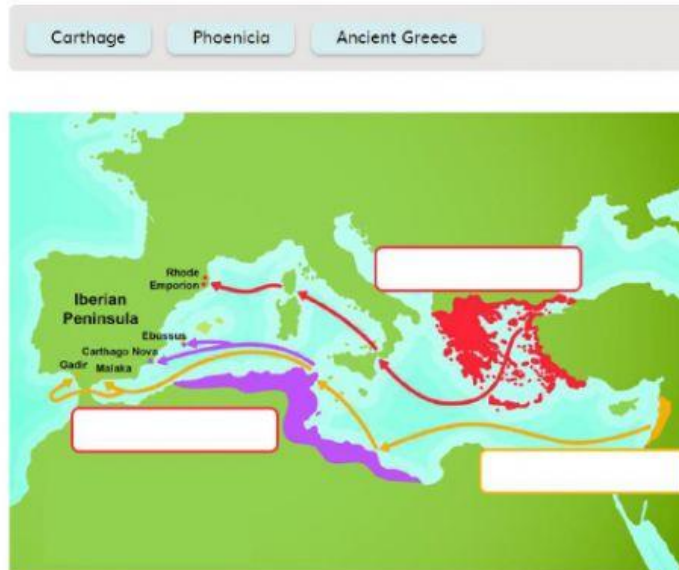


ANCIENT HISTORY IN THE IBERIAN PENINSULA
