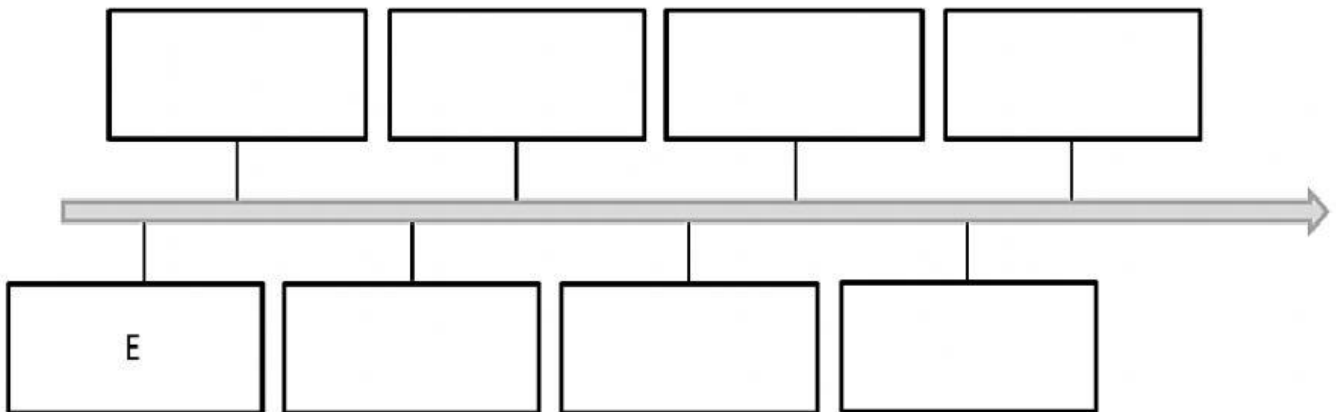
Read about Roman daily life. Circle true or false.
