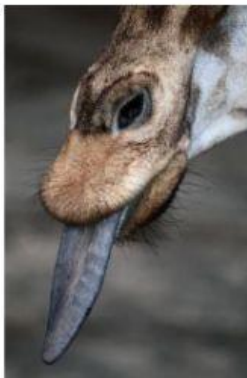
Hello! Welcome to our radio programme!
