



Listening to solve problems

Competence: Students listen critically and respond appropriately to oral communication. (Speakers talk in a manner that guides the listener to understand important ideas by using proper phrasing, pitch, and modulation.).

Achievement indicator: Students demonstrate understanding of sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography).
