-I just saw Justin, Mark and Naomi in the park.

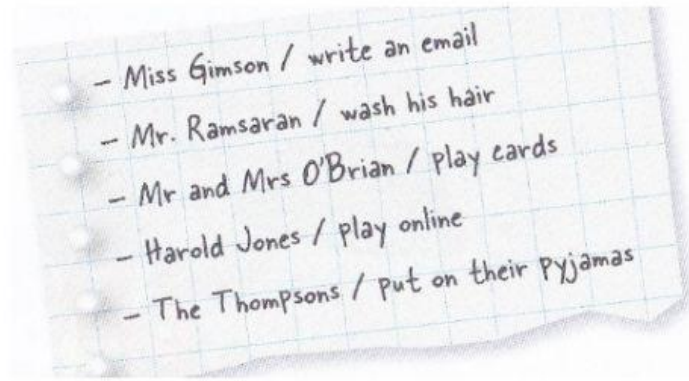
Oh yeah? Whatthey.....(do)?
